How to complete an IRS Form 4506-T for Tax Return Transcript

Individuals who are required to file taxes and selected for verification by the Department of Education must provide Tax Return Transcripts. Individuals can obtain the Tax Transcript online or by submitting an IRS Form 4506-T to the IRS. (https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f4506t.pdf)

To complete the 4506-T, please complete the following lines:

- 1a. Name of Tax Filer
- 1b. Social Security Number of Filer

If a joint return complete lines 2a and 2b with spouse information

- 3—Current address
- 4—Previous address if you have moved in the last 2 years
- Leave line 5 blank. NIU does not use the 3rd party option.
- 6—Transcript Requested—Write 1040 and check the box at the end of the line 6a
- 9—List the last calendar day of the tax year you are requesting the Tax Return Transcript (i.e. if requesting 2021 taxes please list 12/31/2021)
- Read the declaration indicating you are the tax payer listed in line
 1a and check the box above the signature line
- Sign and date the form
- List your phone number
